Introduction

The CommsLabs Chat space is based on an open source project called **Mattermost** and can be considered an alternative to Whatsapp and social media platforms.

Apart from the features described in this page, Mattermost offers a wide array of features through "**plugins**", generally independent projects that create "mini programs" that can be added onto Mattermost.

CommsLabs participants can find each others contacts through the Commslabs.org participant directly: each profile includes the participant's chat alias hyperlinked directly to open a conversation with them.

The Chat space also provides the option to share voice messages, files, videos and establish 1:1 or group voice calls.
